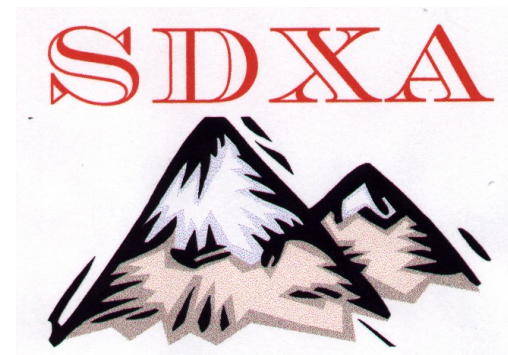

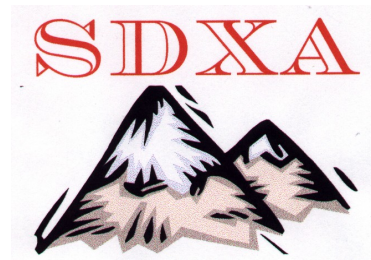
The **Spokane DX Association**
