the monthly meeting was called to order by president WX7B, Chris, at 19:00 local.

### old business:

- 1) a quick comment - the next meeting is at Argonne, as the room at the library near the Y is not available in nov.
- 2) Spokane Hamfest (27sep14); wa0www jay reported:
  - a. thanks much too all the volunteers at the registration table and the hamfest, Betsy noticed the extra help and was very much appreciative.
  - b. the raffle drawing an hour earlier seemed to work fine.
  - c. the VEC testing was very successful; 10 passed: 5 gen, 3 tech and 2-extra.

- 3) wa0www, jay, on contests coming up started with the next PCNWDX trophy contest and that is the CQ WW SSB, 26-27 oct.
  - a. as of now we have 5 claimed scores from the CQ WW RTTY
  - b. oh yes, the salmon run
    - i. wa0www has to report - wow, roving was a blast and fast paced. K7TQ, Randy, organized and put together a superb plan and jay had the truck and radio. the goal was to put 15 counties on the air and we did. Randy sent an great email to the google group with more of the details of the 451 Qs made.
  - c. **note: learned from W3AS, Doug, we don't have to report CQ scores to him anymore, CQ just needs a list of the membership.** (wa0www sent him the list after meeting.)
- 4) club 2meter net report - Randy W7TJ
  - a. working well and another great showing last month.
  - b. W7AL reported that he has approached the trustee of the 147.08 (tone100) repeater and they are more than willing to allow us to use it. since it is with Kootenai country, we need to sign a simple memorandum of understanding. WX7B is ready to sign once we get it.
  - c. had some discussion if we get access to 147.08, should we just move there for everything, DX spotting, the 1/month net and all?

- i. the secretary will admit he got confused as at the beginning of the discussion the feedback is we would use both repeaters and some would use one and others would use the other. this seemed to be missing the point of having the repeater.
- ii. W7AL commented, as he has on the net, the 147.08 is very rarely used, almost not at all and their one net is posted on their site. we should be fine to use it as the one repeater all can listen to all the time.
