 - c. note: learned from W3AS, Doug, we don't have to report CQ scores to him anymore, CQ just needs a list of the membership. (wa0www sent him the list after meeting.)
- 4) club 2meter net report Randy W7TJ
 - a. working well and another great showing last month.
 - b. W7AL reported that he has approached the trustee of the 147.08 (tone100) repeater and they are more than willing to allow us to use it. since it is with Kootenai country, we need to sign a simple memorandum of understanding. WX7B is ready to sign once we get it.
 - c. had some discussion if we get access to 147.08, should we just move there for everything, DX spotting, the 1/month net and all?
