- 12) the SDXA maintains an open DX Packet Cluster at: k7sdx.no-ip.org:7300
 - a. connection can be made through (internet) Telnet with many different applications,
 i. e.g. CC User Program(VE7CC), and many logging programs, e.g. N1MM and DX4WIN
 - b. our cluster is a part of the world wide network of clusters that provide immediate DX spots and announcements. and where we can send spots to the rest of the world.
 - c. primary maintainers of the world wide network, Jim Reisert AD1C and Claudio IW1QLH, are current cleaning up master lists of the global nodes, and just this week reported 237 on their list are no longer responding. some minor concern on losing so many nodes, as the premise and robustness of the overall cluster is the distribution of nodes around the world.
 - d. with that the 3 nodes we were connected to and our entry into the global network have gone off-line so working to back fill. w7al, Al, offered up w7pkt as a possibility and ws7i is helping wa0www, jay with some other possibilities.
 - e. in the mean time we need to re-new our no-ip account and request was to re-new for 4 years, (\$25/yr). after the meeting the officers agreed to go for 2 years, as some questions came up do we need a node here to help out the global network or depend on others. 2 years will give us a chance to figure that out.
