#### SDXA - 05 nov 2016

the monthly meeting was called to order by the prez, wx7b, Chris, at 19:00 local.

#### old business:

- 1) contests:
  - a. 2<sup>nd</sup> contest of the 2016-2017 seasons of 10 DX contests with the other clubs was the CQ WW SSB, and 7 participated, that we know of so far.
  - b. the 2nd contest is coming up:

- 2) Hamfest 24sept16; final committee meeting was 18oct;
  - a. we had ~400 paid admissions and lost about \$400 on the raffle.
  - b. our return was \$775 including the \$500 seed money
  - c. next year we are going to limit the swap tables with a cutoff before the swapfest, had comments too many tables and the handicap could not get around (and many tables were empty).
  - d. N7WRQ, Betsy and KE7PG, Mike have volunteered to stay on as chair and treasurer.
  - e. and for 2017, will need help saturday the 23<sup>rd</sup> of September, 2017.
  - f. the \$500 2017 seed money is due before the next committee meeting on 10jan17.
  - g. n7au moved to approve \$500 seed money for the 2017 Spokane Hamfest, w7bhp 2<sup>nd</sup>, motion passed.

Beginning with the 2016 ARRL Sweepstakes they require a list of Eligible Members before each of the ARRL Contests. The list includes member call signs and six-character grid square. For the Medium and Unlimited Club competition the Club Area can be defined as an ARRL Section.
