



# Amateur Radio General License Class

## **Logistics:**

**Date:** Saturday January 14th, 2023

**Where:** Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, 2511 S. Pines Road, Spokane Valley, WA 99206. Use the door at the West end of the Parking Lot on 26th.

**Time:** From 8:00 am to approx. 2 pm Testing will begin at 30 minutes after the class ends. There will be a 45-minute lunch break at approximately noon. The instructors will be in the classroom during the lunch break and available to answer questions.

**Restrictions:** Class is limited to a max. of 15 students. Depending on Covid situation masks could be required (and are always optional).

**Class Requirements:** The class will be taught using AD7FO's *General License Syllabus*. It is strongly recommended that you download a copy and review it prior to the class. It can be downloaded, viewed and printed from the instructor's web page [www.ad7fo.com](http://www.ad7fo.com) Select the **Training** link tab on the home page, then the **General** Syllabus tab. The class will be taught from a PowerPoint version of this Syllabus.

Currently the Spokane Libraries will print documents for free, up to 80 pages (black and white only) per week if you have a library card. You can break up files into two parts if needed to keep the page count to <80 and then print them on two different weeks. Here is the URL for the Library printing service

**Bring a simple scientific calculator, One that you know how to operate** that can perform basic math functions like add, subtract, multiply, divide, base 10 logarithms, and basic trigonometry. A scientific calculators, like the Texas Instrument TI-30Xa is available at office supply stores, Walmart and Amazon for about \$15. A scientific calculator is also available from the Dollar store that will work for \$1 if you do not have one (not as rugged as the better ones). You will need it for both the class and the exam. **Programmable and Cellular phone calculators are not allowed**

**Cost:** The class is free, but there is \$15 examination fee if you take the exam (cash or check). If you pass you will need to pay an additional \$35 fee directly to the FCC (Federal Communications Commission) within 10 days , this means you will pay a total of \$50. for your license. Information on how to submit your payment to the FCC will be provided during the class.

**License test:** A optional license test session will follow at the end of the class. A photo ID (drivers license, State ID card, passport, military ID, School ID, etc.) with your name and address will be required to take the exam. You will also need a copy of your current technician License that can be left with the Exam Team. The FRN (Federal Registration Number) on your license is needed to tale the exam.

If you just plan to come to the test session you will still need to register. You will receive a confirming email in return verifying you are registered.
