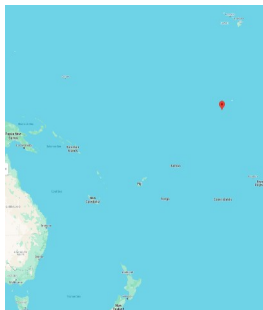

A U.S. National Wildlife Refuge, Jarvis Island was also designated part of the Pacific Remote Islands Marine National Monument in 2009.
